#### Treasurer's Report

Statement of Operations - We have generated \$146.6k in YTD Total Income. Our YTD Expenses are \$151.5k. This puts us at a negative \$5k year to date. However, there are some expenses, from our latest sewer backup in late March, that have not been approved to include in our financials yet. These expenses will hit our books in April (\$5k deductible plus expenses not covered by insurance).

Balance Sheet & Cash Flow - The total of cash and accounts receivable is \$281.7k. Funds allocated to dedicated accounts is \$188.3k.

#### **Facility Loan Update**

The paperwork to secure our \$360,000 loan with Mission Investment Fund, approved in January during a special Congregation Meeting, is progressing. Legal counsel has been obtained to review the agreements and we hope to finalize this week.

A requirement that was not clear during initial conversations, is for OSLC to invest \$15,000 with Mission Investment Fund as part of our partnership with MIF. Council is working with the Endowment Board to shift identified investment dollars from Thrivent to MIF to satisfy this requirement. This investment will be short term, low risk, will earn interest quarterly that will be available to the Endowment Board, and the monies will be returned to

the Endowment Fund at the end of the 3 year Term Investment vehicle selected by the Endowment Board.


Please help us in welcoming Julie Ackerman, who has recently joined our Nursery Attendant team.

#### **OSLC Endowment Fund**

The OSLC Endowment Fund was established by the congregation in the year 2000 to enhance the ministry and mission of our church. The Fund grows through financial gifts in the form of memorials, donations, bequests and legacy giving that are held in an investment account for additional growth. A portion of the income generated from the investment is distributed as grants each spring in the areas of Mission, Outreach, Capital Improvement and Financial aid. Monies and management of the Fund are separate from that of the church operating budget.

Over the past 20 years the Endowment Fund Board has disbursed over \$94,000! Each year we have distributed between \$5000 and \$7000. Every year we have more requests for grants than we are able to fulfill and they are often asking for larger amounts than we are able to give. Our vision is to grow the fund so that we have the ability to give greater support to those who need it. We invite you to help us grow the fund by including a bequest, annuity or other gift to the Endowment Fund in your estate plans. 


